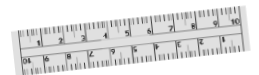
As readers and writers:



We will produce an independent narrative. This narrative will involve 2 or more characters that meet for the first time and explore how the new relationship and dynamic unravels. This is inspired by the book 'On Sudden Hill' by Linda Sarah which focusses on two best friends and their relationship. We will also write a set of instructions which has been influenced by the book 'The Paper Doll's'. We will produce a set of instructions on how to make a paper chain of dolls. The teaching of reading is continued by daily phonics lessons and other reading opportunities. The children develop at their own level and are encouraged with engaging stories.

Spellings will be sent home weekly and are linked to the 100 High Frequency Words.

As mathematicians we are learning to : + =



- Count in 2s
- Count in 5s
- Count in 10s
- Understand the concept of multiplication.
- Find a quarter
- Find a half
- Describe turns and directions

We will explore finding a half for the first time using shapes and sets of objects. We will use the vocabulary 'half' and 'whole'.

As scientists we are:

Learning about the different parts of a plant and what they need to thrive and survive.

We will be learning about Christianity. We will be focusing on how Christians celebrate and worship around the world.

As musicians...

We will continue to enjoy our Musical Bumps sessions where we are learning all about beat, rhythm and pitch.

As budding techies...

We will learn what communication and technology means and how we can use this safely. We will also continue to develop our coding skills and knowledge.



As historians we will be:

focusing on the core concept of historical investigation. Children will study moments and movements that have changed the world.
