Dear Parent/Carers,

This half term we will be learning through the theme of 'Building a Sustainable World'. Children will begin to understand the impact that they have on our world and how to ensure they look after it for future generations.

As readers and writers:

This half term we are reading the book 'The Storm Whale' by Benji Davies. This amazing book will open the children up to new vocabulary and different forms of writing.

The teaching of reading is continued by daily phonics lessons and whole class reading. The children develop at their own level and are encouraged with engaging stories.

Spellings will be sent home with weekly homework and are linked to the sounds that your children are learning in phonics as well as common exception words.

As scientists ...

We will be learning all about 'Everyday Materials'. We are going to develop our curiosity about the world around us. We will be learning about the materials that we see in everyday life and the difference between the object itself and what it is made of.

As Mathematicians we will be learning about:

Number: Place value within 50

- Children count forwards and backwards within 50. Children build on previous learning of numbers to 20.
- They learn about grouping in 10s and their understanding of 1 ten being equal to 10 ones is reinforced.

Measurement: Length and height

- Children use and understand the language of length such as long, longer, short, shorter, tall, taller. They recognise this language will change depending on what type of length they are describing and comparing.
- Children understand that height is a type of length. They should also be exposed to lengths that are equal.

Measurement: Mass and Volume

- Children are introduced to weight and mass for the first time. They may already have some understanding of heavy and light from their own experience of carrying objects.
- Children should begin by holding objects and describing them using vocabulary such as heavy, light, heavier than, lighter than before using the scales to check.

As theologians...

In RE this half term, we will be exploring a range of signs and symbols within Christianity and why they are important.

We will gain a better understanding of different symbols belonging to different religions, what they mean and how this makes a difference in others' lives.

As musicians...

We will continue to enjoy our Musical Bumps sessions where we are learning all about beat, rhythm, and pitch.

As historians and geologists...

We will be learning about fashion through the decades with a link to our Global Goals and thinking about how we can make future fashion more sustainable by re-using fashion from other decades.

As budding techies...

We will be learning how to loop and sequence with programming code and use the internet safely.

As artists and designers...

We will be exploring mono printing and reusing old t-shirts to make t-shirt bags and capes.

As athletes...

We will be improving our dynamic balance and coordination skills as well as working with our classmates to develop our hand-eye skills when passing and receiving balls.

As linguists...

We will be continuing to learn Mandarin. Looking at numbers to 10, days of the week and colours.

As good citizens...

We will be learning about the important work of Wangari Maathai and looking at rules and why they are important. We will be discussing where money comes from as well as learning about the environment and how we can help it.
