As readers and writers...



Our text for this half term is Beverley Naidoo's '*Journey to Jo'Burg*'. We will be exploring setting and character descriptions in '*Journey to Jo'Burg*'. In addition to this, we will compare and contrast the '*Journey to Jo'Burg*' and the historical context of the time. Finally, the children will be planning and publishing their own letter based around '*Journey to Jo'Burg*'. We will also be reading daily and completing VIPERS comprehension questions on a range of texts.

Spelling Shed will continue with focus spellings each week, linked to homework alongside grammar and punctuation. We will also be encouraging the children to continue home reading which can be completed through real books or on MyON.co.uk

As mathematicians we will...

Decimals

- Add and subtract decimals within 1
- Adding decimals- crossing the whole
- Adding and subtracting decimals with the same number of decimal places
- Adding and subtracting decimals with a different number of decimal places
- Adding and subtracting wholes and decimals
- Decimal sequences
- Multiplying and dividing decimals by 10, 100 and 1000

Geometry: Properties of Shape

- Identify angles
- Compare and order angles
- Measuring in degrees with a protractor
- Drawing lines and angles accurately
- Triangles and Quadrilaterals
- Calculate lengths and angles in shapes
- Regular and Irregular polygons
- Reasoning about 3-D shapes

As theologians...

We will be learning about the Sikh place of worship and going on a school trip to visit one.

As computer scientists...

This half term we will be looking at using coding to define when certain parts of a program should run and when they shouldn't. Children will also continue to learn about E-Safety.

As artist and designers...

Children will be creating sculptures and plastic flowers based upon the artist, Dale Chihuly.

As aspiring business people...

We will be learning about different careers in 'Careers Week' and learning about the skills we need for our futures.

As good citizens we will look at...

Relationships and Sex education. We will be looking at what is private and what happens to the body as we age.

As historians we will...

We will be looking at the cause and consequences of the Suffragettes. We will also be using sources of evidence to find information about the past and think critically.

As athletes...

We will be looking at fitness and healthy lifestyles in indoor PE and focusing on object control in Cricket for outdoor PE.



As musicians...

Children will listen and play the music in the community.

As linguists...

Children will be learning about Chinese food and architecture. They will also be learning travelling vocabulary.

As scientists...

Children will be exploring 'Animals including Humans'. This will include looking at life cycles, gestation periods and childhood development.

As geographers...

Children will look at locating Europe's Capital cities and identifying characteristics linked with the 7 continents.
