Dear Parent/Carers,

Welcome back to school and welcome to Year 1. We are so excited to start your Year 1 journey with you! During our first term we will be doing lots of learning that centres around the theme of 'Who am I? and Who am I becoming?'

Attendance

Target: 97.5%

It is important that your child's attendance stays above 97% so that they are not at risk of falling behind.

As readers and writers:



We will be writing our own narrative based on the story 'Beegu' by Alexis Deacon.

We will teach one grammar specific lesson a week. This will incorporate spellings that include the sounds that we have learnt in phonics and also some trickier words. These will be sent home alongside your child's weekly homework. For the rest of the week, we will focus on different plot points from the stories.

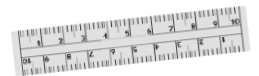
We will be learning to develop creative responses to the text through drama and storytelling. By the end of each unit, the children will produce an independent piece of writing inspired by characters from the book.

We will have daily phonics lessons to support children's reading. This half term we will be recapping some of the trickier Phase 3 and Phase 4 sounds.

As mathematicians we are learning to : + =

Place value within 10 and 20.

We will be learning about place value and continuing to develop our understanding of counting to 10 and up to 20. The children will compare groups and numbers using the $<$, $>$ and $=$ symbols. The children will also order groups and numbers.



Addition and Subtraction within 10.

We will be developing our number and fluency skills in addition and subtraction of numbers within 10. The children will deepen their understanding through the use of part-part whole models, bar models and number lines.

Shapes

We will be learning about 2D and 3D shapes. We will be learning to understand the differences and how to identify each shape.

As scientists we are:

Learning about the Human body. We will learn to identify different parts of the body and understand which parts of the body we use for different activities. We will learn about and be able to identify the 5 senses.

As theologians we will...

Be learning about Christianity. We will be focusing on why Christianity is important to Christians and understanding all our differences.

As musicians we will...

Continue to enjoy our Musical Bumps sessions where we are learning all about beat, rhythm and pitch.

As budding techies we will...

Be using *code.org* to create actions for events. We will learn that the actions that we code can create a specific event.



As Historians we will...

-Explore chronology through exploration of personal timeline.
-Begin to recognise the concept of before and after and newer and older.

As Geologists we will...

-Carry out a study of our local area. We will then compare some human and physical features with our Oasis link country, South Africa. The children will also locate cities and countries on maps.
-Gain some knowledge of the continents of the World including
-Locate UK and Oasis Global area.

As athletes we will...

Be building on our fitness and learning how to control objects.

Who am I and Who am I becoming?

As artists and designers, we will...

-Explore and use a range of media and materials to create self-portraits.
-Understand how to build and design a range of objects selecting suitable materials.

As good citizens we will...

- Know what feelings are
- Recognise what makes us feel happy and sad
- Know what secrets are and to identify what is a good and a bad secret.

As linguists we will...

Be learning about Chinese culture and a typical day in the life of a child in China.

Notices and reminders
