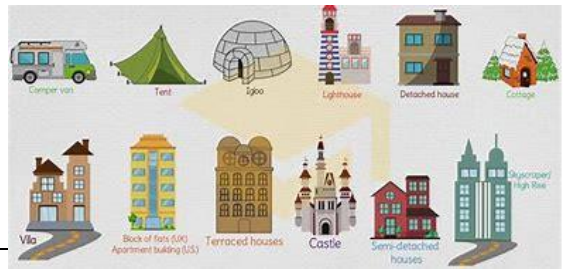
Challenge – Being a good citizen means being responsible. A good citizen includes giving back and helping others. It also means being proactive, being responsible, and thinking of others.
