Cool Milk will increase the price of a portion of milk for children aged 5 or over from 24p to 25p per child per day. Under-5 children will continue to receive milk free-of-charge.

The new price is driven by recent increases in the prices that they pay their dairy partners and also by ever-increasing overheads. Food prices have increased nationwide as farmers and distributors strive to maintain a sustainable business whilst confronted by significant increases in the cost of their feed, fuel, packaging supplies and general operating overheads.

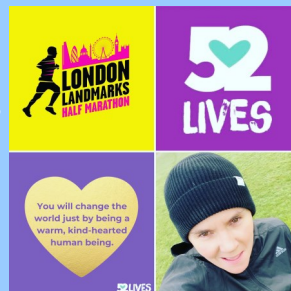
### BookLove

### Olio Food Waste App

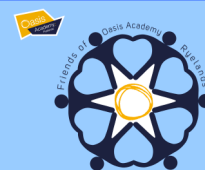
