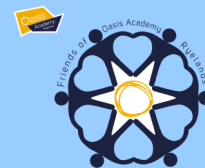
- To give your time to help someone

PE Kits And School Uniform

It has been noticed that some children do not have their PE kits available for lessons. PE kits need to be in school every day, especially as the weather warms up. Teachers may wish to take advantage of the nice weather and add to our PE provision, so please ensure that your child is equipped with everything they need at all times.

COVID Update

On the 1st of April, access to free PCR and LFD testing ends so this means that it is unlikely we will be able to ask children to be tested if they display symptoms linked to COVID.

Following the government changes to testing, please be advised of the procedures for illness and suspected COVID for the summer term.

- Children who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people. They can come back to school when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to attend. Please inform the office of any illness.
- Adults with a positive COVID-19 test result should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 5 days, which is when they are most infectious. For children and young people aged 18 and under, the advice will be 3 days.
