### School Uniform

Please ensure that your children are in the correct school uniform at all times.

#### General Uniform

- Academy sweatshirt or cardigan
- White polo shirt
- Reception to Year 2 - Grey skirt (knee length), trousers or shorts (seasonal)
- Summer blue chequered dress (seasonal/optional)
- Black or grey socks or plain tights
- Sensible black shoes that support the foot (no trainers or boots)
- Academy book bag

Long hair should be tied back or braided so it is out of the child's face. Any hair bands or beads should be either blue, yellow or black.

#### PE Uniform

- White plain round neck t-shirt
- Navy / black plain gym shorts
- Navy / black jogging bottoms (outside/optional)
- Navy / black tracksuit / sweatshirt top (no logos) (outside/optional)
- Trainers/plimsolls

### Nursery Spaces

Do you have a little duckling aged 3? - Apply now for a September 2022 place in our nursery.

Our Duckling class runs Monday to Friday and children attend everyday.

We run two 15 hour sessions: Mornings 8.30 - 11.30 and Afternoons 12.30 – 3.30.

Full Time places are also available.

If you are eligible for 30 hours free childcare from the government, you will pay £25 per week (£5 a day for lunch cover) and you will need to provide your child with a packed lunch. If you are not eligible for the funding, then the cost per week is £125. You will also need to provide a packed lunch for your child.

### Jamf Parent - Managing iPads at Home

Jamf Parent is an app that allows parents/carers to manage their children's school-issued devices. Using Jamf Parent, they can restrict and allow apps and device functionality on their children's devices.

As a parent/ carer, they will be able to do the following:

- Allow and restrict apps
- Enable app lock to set a timer for app restrictions
- Reset a child's PIN code if they have forgot it

Note: Parents/carers can only control the device outside the hours of 8-5 Monday to Friday


