# MANDARIN

In this weeks Mandarin learning, we started the lesson by singing the song 'If you feel happy, clap your hands', accompanied by lots of enthusiastic dancing! We also learned how to build sentences linked to the weather, using a range of vocabulary. Through a blend of animated videos and music, the children did a great job with their pronunciations—I was very impressed :)

This week, in Y1, we reviewed seasons in Mandarin. The children wrote sentences on their show-me boards, using their written Mandarin carefully and thoughtfully.

Y2 students learned how to ask the weather in Mandarin using the sentence they had learned in todays session.

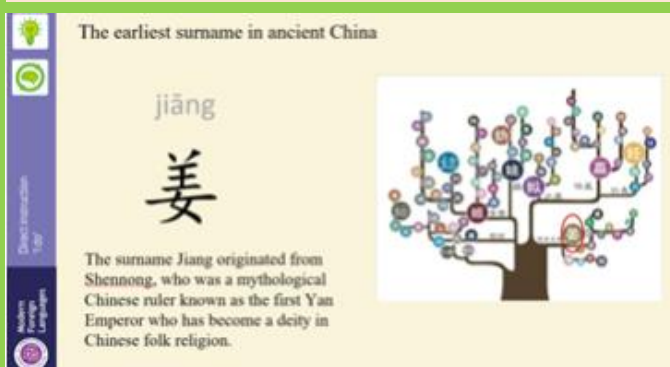
