A Typical Day at Workshops:

9:30am – 10:00am

Registration: During this time, we welcome all the students and they get to know their teachers and other students who they will be working with that day using some fun Drama Based exercises to get to know each other even better.

10:00am – 12:30pm

Session 1: We will start with a full warm up, before getting our teeth stuck in to our main number for the day. During this time we will have a short snack break and there will be plenty of opportunity to visit the toilets.

12:30pm – 1:30pm

Our lunch break is a full hour, but we also offer the opportunity to take part in some arts and crafts during this time to break up the day.

1:30pm – 3:20pm

Session 2: The afternoon session is all about piecing together the mornings work, it could be filming some clips for our music video, or fine tuning our singing for example.

3:20pm – 3:30pm

Performance time: We will put together everything we have done that day into a final performance. Parents are invited to come and see them perform at 3:20pm each day.

What to Bring:

Everyone should bring a full and healthy packed lunch for the day, including a small mid-morning snack. Students should have enough water to last them the whole day. Fizzy drinks are not permitted.

What to Wear:

Students should wear CSTA uniform if they have it or plain black loose comfortable clothing such as tracksuits, leggings, t-shirts etc. Footwear is important and children should be wearing dance shoes or trainers. Please no boots, sandals, crocs or other shoes.
