YEAR 2 SYNAGOGUE VISIT

Last week Year 2 made an exciting trip to Bromley Reform Synagogue as part of their RE topic Judaism. After two very hot and humid bus journeys, Chaffinch and Goldfinch made it to the Synagogue, where they immediately identified the Ark, Bimah, candle for eternal light as well as the Star of David. Year 2 sat patiently and listened intently as Marilyn gave more insight about the life in the Jewish community, asking thoughtful questions throughout. They were in awe when the ark was opened to reveal beautiful, shining Torah scrolls and beat Marilyn to it when they asked her where the Yad was. They were given a tour of the rest of the building, involving discussions about Kosher food and Jewish celebrations.

Marilyn was incredibly impressed by both class's in-depth knowledge and understanding of Judaism, she really enjoyed the children's enthusiasm and engagement. We are very proud of Chaffinch and Goldfinch for their excellent display of learning as well as their respectful behaviour. Well, done Year 2! A special thank you to Marilyn and Bromley Reform Synagogue for providing us with a very enjoyable and insightful trip.

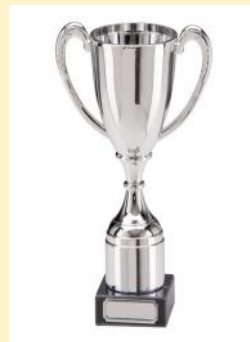
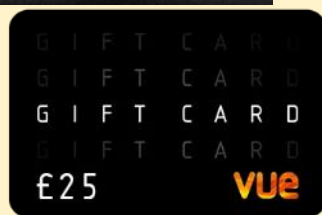
Weekly Attendance Award

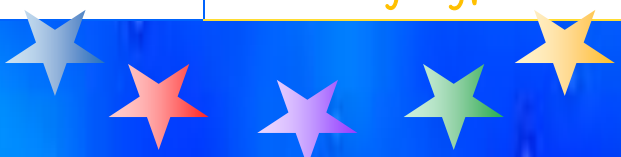
