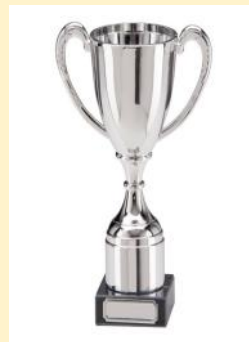
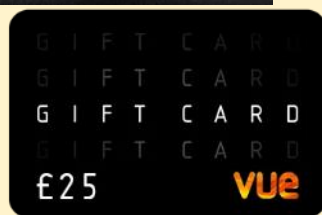
## Weekly Attendance Award
