These are 'Standard Assessment Tests' that are completed throughout a week in May every year by Year 6 children across the country. The children complete a Spelling, a Grammar, a Reading and 3 Maths tests during the week - hard going for everyone! To say I am proud of our children and our staff is an understatement - they have all worked incredibly hard to help prepare for this week and to ensure that everything ran smoothly. It really is a team effort, and I believe that we have the best team - thank you too for supporting us in the way you do. This week has also been Mental Health Awareness Week and today we invited our whole school community to **wear green** in recognition and support of this. 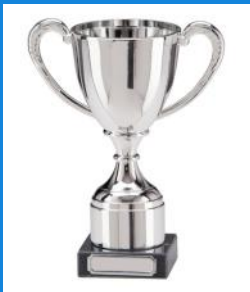
