Miss Swinney and Miss Sales were very impressed with the children's knowledge and speed in answering the multiplication questions, struggling to keep up themselves at some points!!

child, guided by Yvadney, an award winning artist who featured on Portrait Artist of the Year.

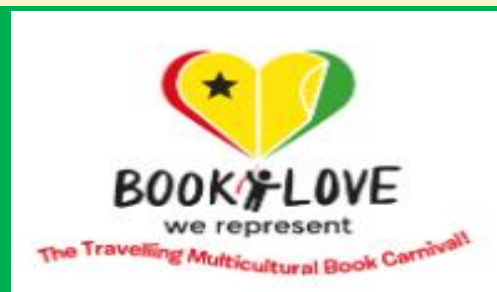
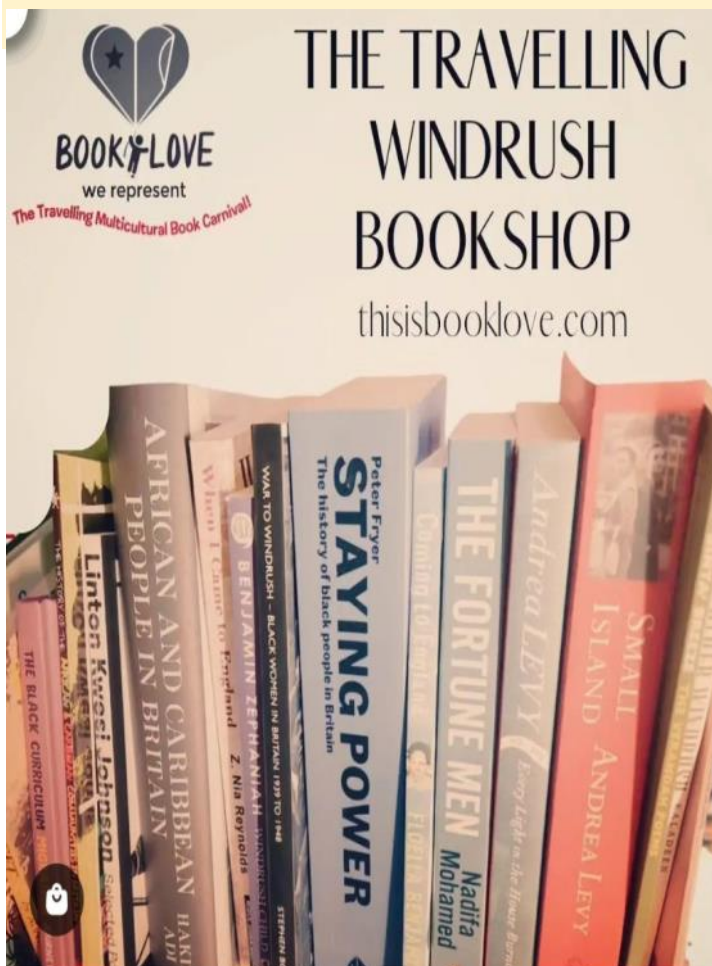
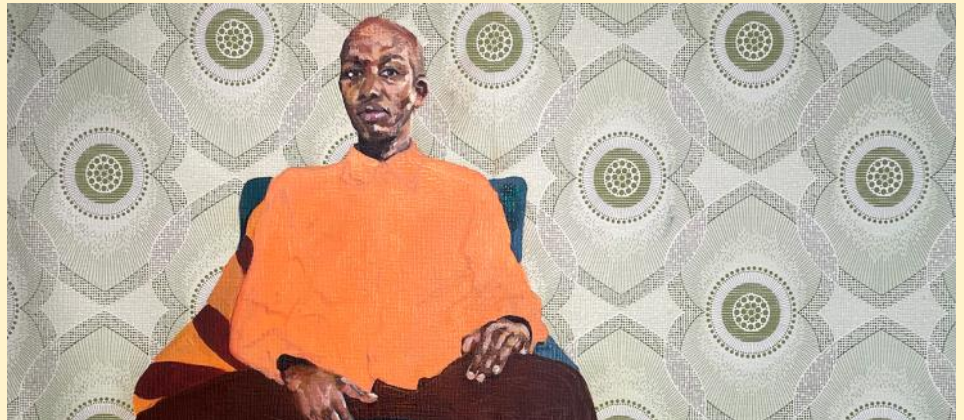

Year 5 Trip to the Natural History Museum

On Wednesday, our Year 5 pupils embarked on an exhilarating field trip to the Natural History Museum in South Kensington. The day was filled with wonder as students explored impressive exhibits, from the towering skeletons of giant dinosaurs that once roamed the Earth to the dazzling display of sparkling crystals and gemstones. The adventure offered a rich blend of science and history, allowing the children to engage with interactive exhibits and participate in hands-on activities designed to ignite their curiosity.

Hintze Hall & Blue Whale: We were greeted by *Hope*, the impressive 25m blue whale skeleton hanging overhead. As well as a full sized giraffe – with and without its skin!

Dinosaurs in the Blue Zone: The dinos were a big hit, children were able to stand next to the *Stegosaurus* and a juvenile *Hypsilophodon Foxii*.

Red Zone – Earth's Forces: We entered the red zone by coming through the middle of the Earth! Pupils tested the earthquake simulator and learned about volcanoes and earthquakes through interactive displays. We revisited some of our science learning from earlier on in the year, exploring the different planets in our solar system.

Green Zone – Bugs, Birds & Gems: We spotted dodos in the bird gallery, examined creepy crawlies revisiting our learning on life cycles and marvelled at dazzling minerals in the Earth's Treasury
