This week the children have been learning about bread. They have learnt where it comes from, how it is made and the huge variety of bread available. They had great fun making currant buns out of bread dough. They mixed and proved and kneaded the dough and shaped it into buns to bake and take home. They also followed instructions to make jam sandwiches which they made and ate in nursery.

Next week's topic is called 'To Market To Market and we will learn about butchers, bakers, fish mongers, dairies and green grocers. We will look at how supermarkets reflect these shops. We will write shopping lists and talk about prices, money and paying for goods.

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Things to do at home this weekend.....
