- If you are late bringing your child to nursery please will you go to the office to sign in, and then wait with your child until a member of staff is available to collect them and bring them round to nursery.
- The initial carpet session is a very important part of your child's education. It is when they embed their learning from the day before, and learn the knowledge and skills for the activities in the session ahead of them. During this time some of the children who need extra support have small group activities with our staff and it is important that this period of learning for all the children is not interrupted.
- As we are unable to have Nursery parents in school, this year's Nursery Christmas Concert will be recorded and shared with you in the last week of school. We will let you know when the video is available to watch, and what platform to use.

This week the children have been learning about supermarkets and other food shops and stalls. They have found out what butchers, bakers, green grocers, fish mongers and chemists sell. We have learnt that supermarkets contain all these areas within their shops. We set up a supermarket role play area where we could buy items, use tills, money and receipts. We wrote shopping lists and price tags for the items in our shop, and counted out pennies to pay for them.

Next week's topic is called 'Music Making' and we will learn how different musical instruments are played and listen to the sounds they make. We will make our own percussion instruments and create a class tune with them.
