
Notices

- Despite our best efforts some of our 4 year olds are really struggling to write their names. Please can you help your child to write their name everyday. You can model the correct way to write it (in lower case apart from the first letter) and then write it in dots so that your child can trace over it to become familiar with the letters. Help them to start the letters at the correct point, and keep showing them the correct way to hold a pencil so that eventually it will click. A big thank you to the parents who are obviously working with their children at home, they are really benefitting from your input

This week the children have been learning how to stay safe. We have talked about stranger danger, getting lost, dangerous objects within the home and road safety. The children have been encouraged to learn their house number and road name, and how to ring 999 in an emergency situation if their carers are in difficulty. We had fun dressing up as road safety characters and practiced how to cross the road safely.

Next week's topic will be 'Where we live'. We will look at local maps and the features of our local area. (Country Park, trams, library, swimming pool, types of houses and buildings etc.)
