Jovina for always smiling and for doing some great counting!



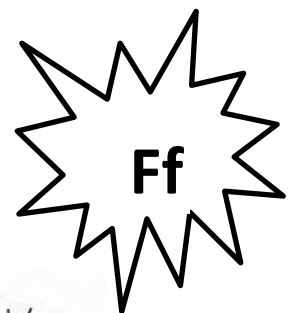
Reuben for always saying interesting things and using fabulous language!
