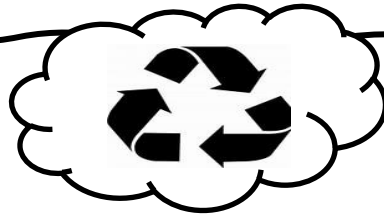

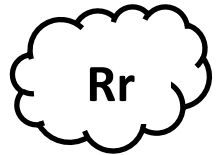

## Next weeks topic: Re-cycling

We will be learning what 're-cycling' means. We will discover what effect it has on the world when we don't re-cycle and re-use things. We will decide what things we can be re-cycled and what they can be made in to. We will sort through objects that can be re-cycled and those that can't, and try to understand why. We'll think about why we should use less plastic and think about what we should do with our old toys and clothes and why it's important not to waste food.

## Things to do at home...
