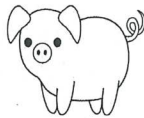
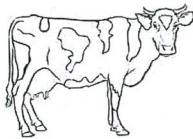
Stars of the week:

Next weeks topic: Farm animals

We will learn to name farm animals and they're young. We will find out which animals are kept on farms to produce food such as meat, eggs, milk, cheese, yoghurt etc. and which are there to work eg. sheep dogs, cats and horses. We will compare farm animals to pets and wild animals and think about the differences between them. We will also look at the type of homes the farm animals live in... eg. coops, fields, barns, grass, stables, mud, sties, pens or water.
