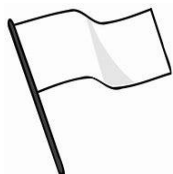
Stars of the week:

We will find out that wind is moving air. We will look at vehicles powered by wind, recreation activities, machines, gadgets etc. that rely on wind to move (for example wind turbines, windmills, balloons, yachts, gliders, kites, flags, wind surfers). We will think about how the wind makes you feel? What things do you like to do in the wind? We will talk about the recent wind storm and the damage it can cause.
