## Next weeks topic: Easter

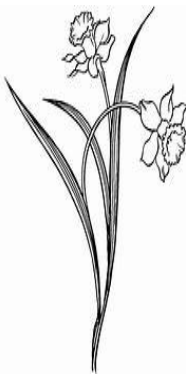
