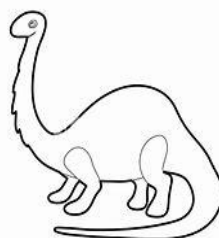
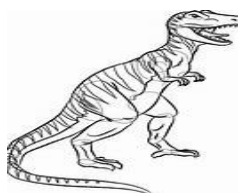
## Stars of the week:
