We will be talking about our emotions. We will think about how and why our feelings change, and how to deal with different emotions. We will think about how to be aware of other people's feelings and how we can have empathy for them. We will look at facial expressions and body language for happy, sad, frightened, surprised, grumpy etc.



Before we start learning a letter each week, we will spend this half term learning to distinguish environmental sounds, rhymes and rhythm. This will build a solid foundation for learning letter sounds later.



Things to do at home this weekend.....

Please help your child to recognise their name. Encourage them to learn the first letter and sound of their name, and tracing over it with their finger.

Practice counting and recognising numbers

Take it in turns to copy each other's clapping patterns, this will train your child's ear to listen carefully
