

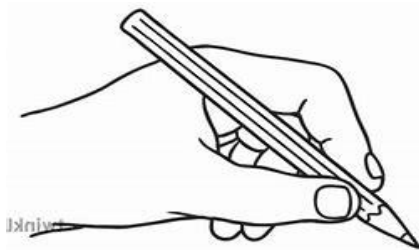
Nursery newsletter

Always correct your child's pencil grip, it will save a lot of time later and will ultimately make it much easier for them to write. It is very hard for them to unlearn bad habits later!

Things to do at home this weekend.....

Talk to your child about the members of their immediately and extended family: grandparents, aunts, uncles, cousins, step-brothers/sisters/parents etc.

Once your child is secure at counting 1:1 objects, help them to name numerals to 10 and to be able to recognise each one out of order.

Help your child to write their name using the correct Tripod pencil grip.
