Topic First Week back: Fireworks!

We will look at some spectacular firework displays and talk about the colours and shapes we see, and the noises we hear. We will try to recreate some of the noises using instruments or our bodies and we'll learn a new song incorporating them. We will make our own junk model fireworks and draw/paint/chalk our own beautiful displays! In maths we will concentrate on shapes.

Things to do at home...

Help your child to describe shapes and colours and model interesting vocabulary to them to expand their knowledge and enrich their language experience.

Practice name writing with your child paying attention to the letters and sounds in their name, and of course making sure they use a pinch tripod grip.

Practice counting objects with 1:1 accuracy
