Next week's Topic: Autumn

We will look at all the changes that take place in Autumn. We will think about what happens to the weather, animals, plants, trees, the food we eat and the activities we do. We will count and weigh conkers, cones, leaves and twigs and use them to make repeating patterns. We will make collages with natural autumnal artefacts and make beautiful leaf prints.

Help your child to describe the Autumn changes they see around them when you go for a walk, model new vocabulary to them such as hibernation, nocturnal, seasons etc.

Ask your child to carefully count, with 1:1 accuracy, the cones, leaves, and pebbles they collect/find in the park

Ask your child to tell you the initial sounds of words. There are now many children ready to sound out CVC words such as cat, dog, red, hat etc. please practice with them
