Next week's Topic: Where food comes from

We will be finding out where our food comes from before it reaches the shops and markets. We will explore different types of farms and factories and learn the difference between markets, supermarkets, shops, butcher, baker, greengrocer, dairy and fishmonger. We will try to understand the difference between natural food and processed food, and vegetarian, vegan and meat diets. We will decide what is a healthy plate of food and an unhealthy one. We will look at how supermarkets also divide food up into types. We will talk about where we shop for food with our grown-ups and what's on our shopping list. We will also think about how we pay for food (coins, notes and cards) and look at the idea of prices, and the meaning of expensive and cheap.

Help your child to think of items you need for a shopping list

Draw attention to price labels in the supermarket and ask your child to say the numbers they see

Point out the signs telling you what's on sale, look at the pictures displayed

Play the memory game 'I went top the supermarket and I bought...'

Help your child to write numbers and of course make sure they use a pincer grip.
