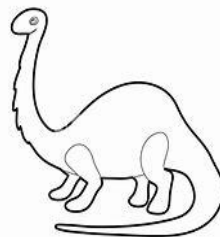
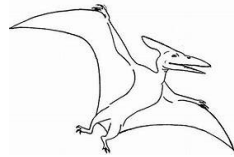
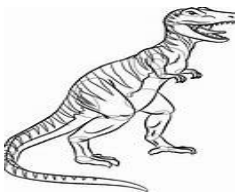
Stars of the week:

Things to do at home...
