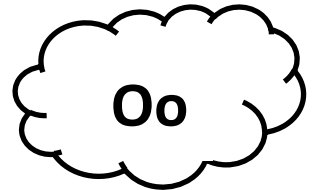

Next weeks topic: Easter

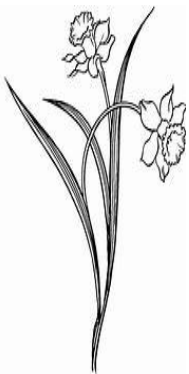
