Stars of the week:

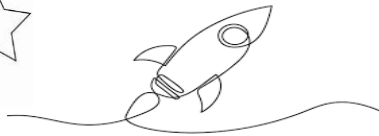
Blake for making a story book and telling the whole class a brilliant story!

Next weeks topic: Space

Things to do at home...

- Explore the concept of space with your child using language such as satellites, rockets, asteroids, planets, planet names, shooting stars

- Ask your child to help you count things out around the home (eg socks, cutlery, books etc) making sure they touch or move each object as they count to ensure accuracy
