Next week's theme is....How do you Feel?

We will be talking about our emotions. We will think about how and why our feelings change, and how to deal with different emotions. We will think about how to be aware of other people's feelings and how we can have empathy for them. We will look at facial expressions and body language for happy, sad, frightened, surprised, grumpy etc.



Before we start learning a weekly letter sound each week we will spend this half term learning to distinguish environmental sounds, rhymes and rhythm. This will build a solid foundation for learning letter sounds later.

Please help your child to recognise their name. Encourage them to learn the first letter and sound of their name, and tracing over it with their finger.
