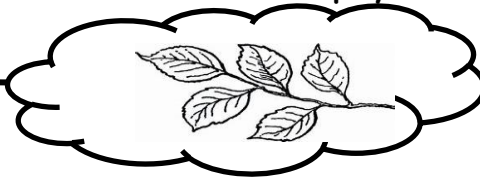

## Next weeks topic: Autumn Antics

We will look at all the changes that take place in Autumn. We will explore what happens to the weather, animals, plants, trees, the food we eat and the activities we do. We will count and weigh conkers, cones, leaves and twigs and use them to make repeating patterns. We will make collages with natural autumnal artefacts and make beautiful leaf prints. We will also make our roleplay area into a hibernation den for our cuddly animals.

## Things to do at home...

Help your child to describe the Autumn changes they see around them when you go for a walk Colours, temperature, smells, natural debris on the ground

Ask your child to carefully count, with accurate 1:1 correspondence, the cones, leaves, twigs they collect, model how to line them up and touch each one as they say a number name

Practice name writing with your child paying attention to the letters and sounds in their name, and of course making sure they use a tripod grip.
