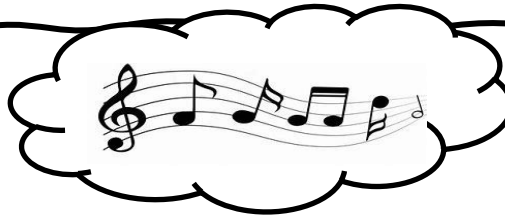

### Next weeks topic: Making Music

The children will try to identify different instrument sounds, and they will also listen to different genres of music and talk about what they liked/disliked about them. We will explore what sequence, pattern, rhythm, loud, soft, beat etc. mean. We'll make our own percussion instruments and play in our class band! We will have fun making up body percussion sound sequences for our friends to copy.
