Next weeks topic: Re-cycling

We will be learning what 're-cycling' means. We will discover what effect it has on the world when we don't re-cycle and re-use things. We will decide what objects can be re-cycled and think about what they could be made in to. We will sort objects into ones that can be re-cycled and those that can't.
