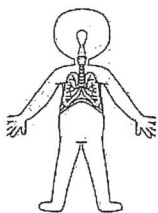

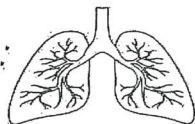

We will learn to name the main parts of our bodies and find out what their function is. We will look inside our body at our major organs, and our skeleton and we will discover what X-rays are. We will learn why we have skin, veins, brains, bones, muscles, heart, lungs etc and we will find out how they help us to stay alive and how hospitals help us when we get ill. We will play games and sing songs to help us locate our body parts, and we will paint our own hand X-rays!

Things to do at home

- Look at a simple image of a skeleton/anatomy and name and locate the main parts (skull, spine, hips, knees, elbows, shoulders, neck, heart, chest, lungs, stomach etc)
- When you share stories with your child, always discuss the pictures and each part of the story as you read, talking about how the characters feel, what might happen next, which character you'd like to be and why or how you could change the story ending.
- Practice counting everyday objects with 1:1 accuracy and reciting numbers in order confidently (as high as they can go!)
- Draw attention to the initial sounds of words
