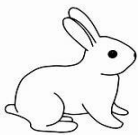

Things to do at home

- Discuss what pets need for a happy and healthy life

- When you read to your child always take the time to model language to them by discussing the story, the pictures, the characters, how the characters feel, what could happen next, what would you do? This will really help to broaden their vocabulary and language skills.
