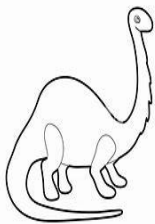

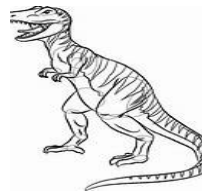
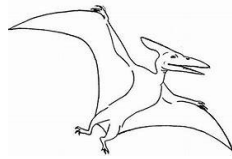
Sofia for trying hard to listen on the carpet

Things to do at home

- Look at dinosaur pictures with your child, find out the names, ask your child to describe how they look, modelling descriptive vocabulary (enormous, scales, armour, fierce, herbivore, carnivore, fossil, extinct, claws etc)
- If your child is finding it hard to grip a pencil properly give them tasks that strengthen their finger muscles such as picking up grains of rice, lentils etc or any small objects that involve the same pincer movement
