All the children are stars this week! We are so proud of their behaviour during the farm visits and the reptile experience, which was exceptional 😊

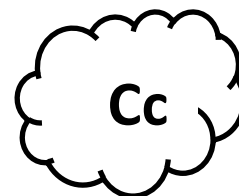
## Next week's topic is Easter
