Next weeks topic: Living Eggs

We are continuing our life-cycles theme with some exciting hands-on real-life experience. We are having some eggs delivered with an incubator and brooder and the children will be able to watch the eggs hatch and the chicks grow and develop each day. They will learn to look after the chicks by helping to clean out the brooder and check food and water daily. We will count the new eggs that hatch each day, learn whether they are male or female chicks and watch their bodies change and develop as they grow.
