Next weeks topic: Space

We will try to understand what space is, where it is, and how big it is! We will talk about the atmosphere, the planets and space travel. We will think what it might be like to be an astronaut and to fly in a rocket and work on a space station. We will create a space station in our role play area and use our imaginations as we fly into space! We will make rockets, satellites etc. out of junk modelling and we will cook star biscuits!

Things to do at home...

- Explore the concept of space with your child using language such as satellites, rockets, asteroids, planets, planet names, shooting stars
- Please encourage your children to talk to you using simple sentences rather than single words. Always model full sentences back to them.
- Please practice name writing with correct letter formation, it is very hard for your child to unlearn bad habits in reception
- Ask your child to help you count things out around the home (eg socks, cutlery, books etc) making sure they touch or move each object as they count to ensure accurate counting.
