## Next week's theme is...Marvellous Me

We will tell our new friends all about ourselves; what we like and don't like, who's in our family, our favourite toy, colour, food, etc. We will proudly tell our friends all the things we are good at, and all the things we want to be good at. We will also look at our friends and then look at ourselves in a mirror to see what features are different and which ones are similar. We will realise that we are all different in lots of ways and that life is much more fun and interesting like that!



Before we start learning a weekly letter/sound, we will spend this half term learning to distinguish environmental sounds, rhymes and rhythm. This will build a solid foundation for learning letter sounds later.



## Things to do at home this weekend.....

Please help your child to recognise their name. Encourage them to recognise the first letter and to make the initial sound. Get them used to the shape/pattern of their name (a long/short word, with tall/short letters at beginning/end/middle) Encourage them to trace their initial letter with their finger and to write it in the air.

Sing nursery rhymes with your children so they begin to recognise rhyme and rhythm within language
