

# Nursery newsletter

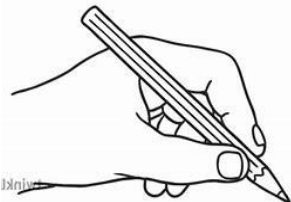

The expectation in nursery is that the children join being able to use the toilets independently, and while we support the children verbally with toileting procedures, we do not wipe the children's bottoms for them.
