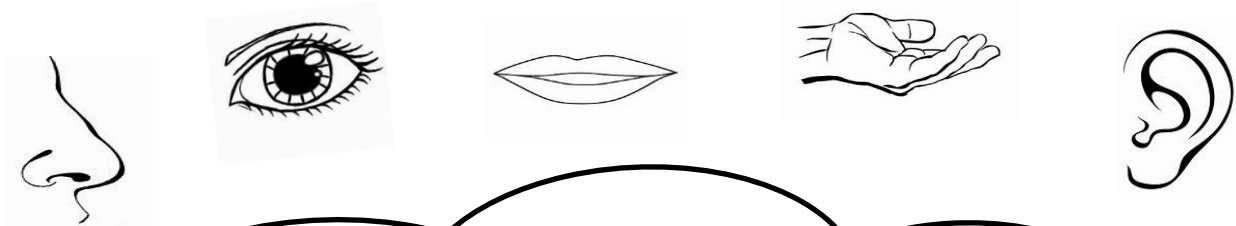

The next theme is...Sensational Senses

We will learn about our five senses and how they help us make sense of the world around us. We will explore textures inside a feely bag and try to describe what we feel, and guess what it might be. We will also test our listening skills by trying to identify different funny or familiar sounds, and we will explore how much we can hear when we cover up our ears and how it feels to walk with our eyes closed!

Things to do at home this weekend.....

You can help your child to describe what they see, hear, taste, smell and touch. Model descriptive language to them to encourage dialogue and questions.

For Example: I can smell the dinner I wonder what it will be. What does it smell like? What do you think it will taste like?

Can you hear the rain/wind/tap running? What does it sound/look like? What does water feel like?

What noises can you hear on the way to school/park? What does a car sound/look like? How does a fir cone/conker/twig/leaf smell/feel/look? What noise do they make as you walk on them?
