## Things to do at home...

Help your child to describe the Autumn changes they see around them when you go for a walk  
Colours, temperature, smells, natural debris on the ground

Ask your child to carefully count, with accurate 1:1 correspondence, the cones, leaves, twigs they collect, model how to line them up and touch each one as they say a number name
