Next weeks topic: Making Music

The children will try to identify different instrument sounds, and talk about what they liked/disliked about them. We will explore timbre, sequence, pattern, rhythm, volume, etc. We'll make our own percussion instruments and play in our class band! We will have fun making up body percussion sound sequences for our friends to copy.

Things to do at home...

Make up a short sequence of sounds for your child to memorise and copy (e.g. stamp feet twice, clap hands three times, bang a tin with a spoon, blow two raspberries etc) Now ask your child to make up a sequence for you to follow

This develops the all-important listening skills, concentration, and recall.
