We will be thinking about all the people who help us in our community. We will talk about the roles of the emergency services, and we will recreate an Emergency Services call centre in our role play area.

We will also think of other people that help us live our lives such as bin men, delivery people, dentists, doctors, nurses, TA's, plumbers, electricians, mechanics, builders, teachers, bus, train and tram drivers etc. We will think how difficult our lives would be without these people providing services for us.
