## Things to do at home...

When you read with your child:

- discuss the story and pictures with them, modelling interesting vocabulary and longer sentences as you talk.
- ask questions throughout, not only to gauge their understanding, but also to help them practice giving explanations and to organise their thoughts into clear sentences
- When you are out and about draw attention to common signs and print in the environment (eg simple road/pavement signs, shop logos, adverts, notices, car registration letters/numbers etc)
