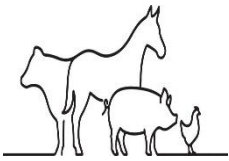

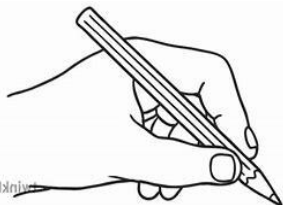
- Next Friday 10th children wear yellow and donate £1 to a children's mental health charity
