Topic first week back : Fireworks



We will look at the colours, smells, shapes and sounds that come with bonfire night. We will look at some fireworks displays on our IWB and then try to mimic the sounds with percussion instruments and draw shapes in the air and on the big board to mimic them (spirals, zig-zags etc). We will make our own colourful 'fireworks' to hang in the classroom and we'll create beautiful pictures with fluorescent paints and glitter on black paper.

Things to do at home over half term...

Please help your child to be able to:

- put on and do up their coats independently as they will be taking them on and off constantly throughout Autumn and Winter
- pull their coat sleeves out when they are inside out!
- put on mittens independently. Please **no gloves** unless you have taught your child to put them on themselves, as you can appreciate it is impossible for us to put 56 gloves on 280 tiny fingers as they constantly move from inside to outside throughout the day!!
